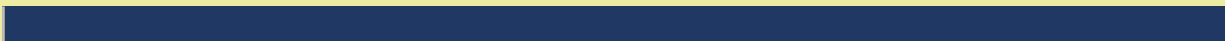
◆ Every Friday, we have extracurricular activities such as Silambam, Karate, Skating, and Chess classes, which are conducted by experts.

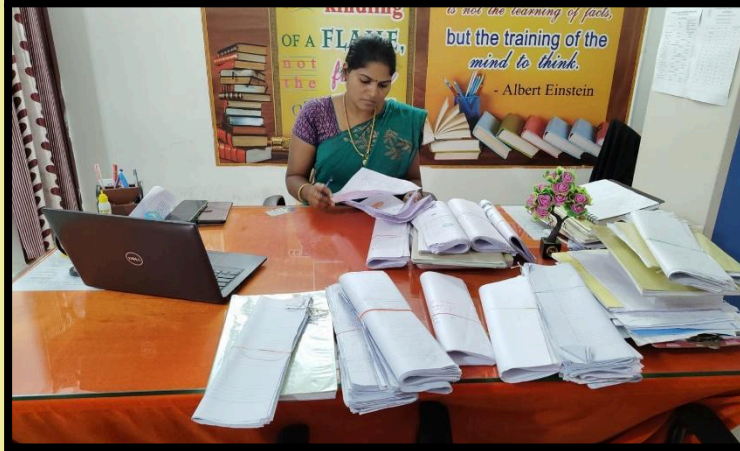
